	8	DIG FOOTINGS & SET POSTS/PIERS	Professional digging and setting of posts/piers in concrete We use precision tools to ensure everything is plumb, level and properly centered	Check and approve the final height and positioning of the posts before concrete is set (as requested)
	9	EXPERT BUILD & FINISHING	Skilled, licensed tradesmen construct the frame, install decking/fencing, stairs, and railings using exceptional craftsmanship	Provide feedback on ongoing work and confirm satisfaction with the progress and quality of the construction
	10	FINAL INSPECTION & PROJECT COMPLETION	We coordinate the final municipal inspection to officially close the permit Apply protective finishes (stain/sealant) if required by contract	Complete the final walk-through, approve the finished project, and sign the completion documents



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MATERIAL PROS & CONS: DECKING AND FENCING

FEATURE	WOOD DECKING (PRESSURE-TREATED/CEDAR)	COMPOSITE DECKING (WOOD/PLASTIC BLEND)	VINYL FENCING (PVC)
INITIAL COST	Lowest upfront cost	Higher than wood (30-60% higher)	Higher than wood
AESTHETICS	Natural beauty and authentic wood feel; can be stained any color	Excellent modern appearance: mimics wood grain but is still synthetic	Consistent, clean, and often bright white; modern styles can mimic wood
MAINTENANCE	High Requires regular cleaning, staining, or sealing every 1-3 years to prevent rot, warping, and fading	Low Requires only occasional soap-and-water cleaning No sanding, sealing, or staining needed	Very Low Requires only occasional soap-and-water cleaning; holds color
DURABILITY	Moderate Prone to splintering, cracking, and rot if not maintained Typical lifespan is 10-15 years (PT) to 20 years (Cedar)	High Resistant to rot, insects, and splintering Superior performance in harsh GTA weather Lifespan is 25+ years	High Resistant to moisture, pests, and rot Will not splinter or warp Lifespan is 20-30 years
LONG-TERM VALUE	Higher cost over time due to recurring maintenance expenses (stain, sealant, labor)	Lower cost over time due to minimal maintenance and longer lifespan	Most cost-effective over the long run due to near-zero maintenance
REPAIR	Easy Individual boards can be cut out and replaced easily	More complex Repair often requires replacing the entire length of the board	More expensive Repair usually means replacing a full panel section



STRUCTURAL & FOUNDATION MATERIALS NOTE

The long-term success of your deck or fence relies heavily on the quality of the materials used **below the surface** and for the main **frame**. Unlike the visible boards (decking or fence pickets), the structural frame must withstand heavy loads, frost cycles, and moisture.

- **DECK STRUCTURE**

- **FOOTINGS/PIERS (FOUNDATION):**

- **Material:** Poured concrete footings, or pre-formed concrete piers (like patio stones for low-level decks) resting on firm, undisturbed soil. In the GTA, footings **must** extend below the **frost line** (typically 4 feet or 1.2 meters deep) to prevent winter frost heave from shifting the deck.
- **SweetHome Spaces Standard:** We use materials and depths that meet or exceed the Ontario Building Code and local Mississauga requirements to ensure maximum stability.

- **FRAMING (POSTS, BEAMS, JOISTS):**

- **Material: Pressure-Treated (PT) Lumber** is the industry standard. It's chemically treated to resist rot and insect damage, making it ideal for **ground contact** and framing applications.
- **Note:** Even if you choose low-maintenance composite decking, the **sub-structure must still be pressure-treated wood** or another highly durable structural material.

- **FENCE STRUCTURE**

- **Posts (Foundation):**

- **Material:** Typically, **Pressure-Treated (PT) 4x4 or 6x6 lumber** set in concrete.
- **Installation:** Posts should be set with concrete extending below the frost line for maximum stability against the wind and freeze/thaw cycle.
- **Alternative: Steel Posts** (like post-saver systems) offer superior longevity, isolating the wood post from ground moisture for decades.

- **Rails/Stringers:**

- **Material: Pressure-Treated lumber** (usually 2x4s) used to connect the vertical posts and support the fence pickets (or panels).
